

2011 Champoux Vineyard



The 2011 Champoux shows pronounced red and black fruit. Red currant, blueberries, and blackberries show through very elegantly. These qualities are backed up by both herbal and spice components such as cedar, and tobacco. Tertiary characteristics include both almonds and cinnamon. The Cabernet supports a structure, which has a pronounced complexity of both fruit and non-fruit notes; these later qualities the Merlot and Cabernet franc. This wine will undoubtedly become even more sophisticated over the next few years.

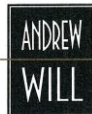
